The Pike Township Trustees met in a regular session March 19, 2024 for the purpose of conducting the business at hand.

The Meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by the President Adam Steele, with Greg Kaffenbarger answering the roll call. Also in attendance was Jerry Donnelly, Scott Williams, Bob Miller and Cheryl Sigler.

All attendees stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

R# 27 / 2024 APPROVE MARCH 5, 2024 MINUTES

Motion by Mr. Kaffenbarger seconded by Mr. Steele approve the March 5, 2024 meeting minutes. Motion passed.

Bob advised the crack fill machine will be coming the first of next month. He received a quote for a new machine, Trustees not interested at this time as we get the use of one at no charge with the purchase of crack fill material and the material would only be \$.14 cheaper per pound if we purchased a machine. He received a Right of Entry letter signed by Mr. Landes for the School Road project. He let a gentleman from the Historical Society into Black Cemetery on Saturday to take pictures. He is still waiting on Jent Mechanical to come install the heater in the pole barn, he is still pursuing a quote for a tarp for the salt barn. He said TC Holzen had a break in and a roll of copper wire was taken and a golf cart from Sugar Isle found back on Sigler Road.

Scott advised he has a EMTP starting in April that wants to work mainly the night shift, they are working on SOP updates as per the response from Christian Sorg at the County Prosecutors office. Cheryl received an email from Christian yesterday, he was advising us that he is joining a private practice and will slowly be giving he workload over the Andrew. Cheryl asked is there is a training schedule with First Citizens Fire? Yes.

R# 28 / 2024 CONTRACT WITH CITIZENS FIRE FOR 2024 TRAINING NOT TO EXCEED \$5000

Motion by Mr. Kaffenbarger, seconded by Mr. Steele to contract with Citizen Fire Training for 2024 training at a cost not to exceed \$ 5000.00. Motion passed.

Scott said there will be EMS trainings done this year too at no charge, 5 from Kettering Network and 3 from Premier, they are scheduled for Wednesday evenings.

Jerry provided a copy of the contract with Nicodemus for the auction March 26th. Bob asked if he could add the old meeting chairs to the sale, Mr. Steele gave him the Auctioneers phone number to call. Jerry advised he has met with Jeff Hoblitt for the Firehouse construction project and he will work up a quote, but can not do any work until June. Cheryl advised she has gotten the Insurance invoice and breakdown for property and liability insurance and needs some appropriation fund additions.

Roll call vote: Mr. Steele; yes Mr. Kaffenbarger; yes Motion passed.


