R# 11 / 2024 PAY BILLS FOR FEBRUARY 2024

Motion by Mr. Davidson, seconded by Mr. Kaffenbarger to pay bills for February 2024. Motion passed.

R# 12 / 2024 APPROVE JANUARY 16, 2024 MINUTES

Motion by Mr. Kaffenbarger seconded by Mr. Davidson to approve the January 16, 2024 meeting minutes. Motion passed.

Scott advised and provided a receipt for the Spectrum equipment on 2-5-2024, Mr. Davidson advised he heard back from the County Prosecutor regarding marijuana and was advised we can follow the same rule as alcohol, so this will not be tested for during a pre-employment exam, he will forward a copy of that email to Scott and Jerry to put with the SOPs. 
R# 14 / 2024 INCREASE APPROPRIATION 2031-110-389 \$ 5,000.00


Roll call vote: Mr. Steele; yes Mr. Davidson; yes Mr. Kaffenbarger; yes Motion passed.
