R# 57 / 2024 APPROVE JULY 2, 2024 MINUTES

Motion by Mr. Kaffenbarger seconded by Mr. Davidson approve the July 2, 2024 meeting minutes. Motion passed.

R# 58 / 2024 SUNRISE PREPAY PROPANE PROGRAM

Motion by Mr. Kaffenbarger seconded by Mr. Davidson participate in the Sunrise Prepay propane program 2000 gallons for FH and 1000 gallons for pole barn at a cost of \$ 1.899 per gallon \$ 5335.98. Motion passed.

R# 59 / 2024 INCREASE APPROPRIATION BUDGETS FOR MEDICARE WITHHOLDINGS

Motion by Mr. Davidson seconded by Mr. Kaffenbarger to increase appropriation codes \$ 200 each to pay Medicare withholdings 2031-330-213 and 2141-330-213.

R# 60 / 2024 APPROVE PAYMENT TO RILEY'S ASPHALT PAVING

Motion by Mr. Kaffenbarger seconded by Mr. Davidson approve payment to Riley's Asphalt Paving \$ 750.00 for 10900 Sigler Road driveway patch where culvert pipe was installed. Motion passed.

Jerry advised electrician came in for FH project, a house on Spence Road found some WWII mortars, the bomb squad from Wright Patt came, removed them, took them to the firehouse, buried them and detonated them, Bob had to bring in some extra dirt to fill the hole.

Bob advised roads and cemeteries all mowed before July 4th, crack filling will take 3 more days, he cleaned up a tree that fell on Sigler Road after Sunday storm. He will be getting a quote for new front tires for the JD mowing tractor.

8:47 a.m. Angela Griest from German Township enters.


