The Pike Township Trustees met in regular session June 2, 2026 for the purpose of conducting the business at hand. The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by the President Greg Kaffenbarger, with Vice President Adam Steele and Dan Maxson answering the roll call. Also in attendance was Jerry Donnelly, Scott Williams, Nicole LeDent and Cheryl Sigler.

All attendees stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

**R# 51 / 2026 APPROVE MAY 19, 2026 MINUTES**

Motion by Mr. Steele, seconded by Mr. Maxson to approve May 19, 2026 minutes. Motion passed.

**R# 52/ 2026 PAY BILLS FOR JUNE 2026**

Motion by Mr. Maxson seconded by Mr. Steele to pay bills for June 2026. Motion passed.

Scott advised 216 runs to date, 14 since last meeting 1 MA with NC. Better Dr verification done, Brett Brown is off the training schedule and on regular schedule, power cot purchased from Govdeals for Medic 353, they will be selling the current cot on govdeals. The turnout gear has been received, Cheryl would like to increase the Fire fund for these recent purchases. Cheryl advised she received notice of the Summer 2026 semester EMT classes at Rhodes State College for Steven Frost. Scott asked Cheryl if she has heard from Pfund regarding the contract for the 2027 Medic, she has not.

Scott had advised Cheryl to go ahead and pay the Boundtree invoice for the drill and needles, she had him review the other 3 outstanding bills for approval to pay, he approved.

Jerry advised 6 runs since last meeting. June 10<sup>th</sup> is the hose testing, he had to order 1 more set of boots. The Fire Department was given a \$ 2500 donation from Grace Gospel Church in St. Paris, they will send out a thank you and Cheryl will deposit the check. Cheryl advised that she applied for the \$ 1000 OTARMA Fire/EMS MORE Grant submitting the receipts for the stair chair and it was granted and check has been deposited. 6-1-26. Once the turn out gear is paid for, she will submit another MORE \$ 1000 Grant to OTARMA with that receipt. He submitted notice from the County regarding the new address established at 11545 Stafford Road.

Mr. Maxson and Me. Steele both looked at the drainage problem on Carriage Hill, there is an issue and Clark County Soil and Water will be out to look at the issue.

Mr. Steele met a lady on Quail Ridge that had a water backup problem and a gusher in her yard, Mr. Steele contacted Clark County Water and Soil and they will look at that issue as well. ***Just a note: Friday May 22-Saturday May 23<sup>rd</sup> we had hard rains and massive flooding in many areas.*** He also looked at the curbing while there and his thoughts are the Twp should be responsible for the upkeep of the curbing. There are holes developing in the asphalt overtop of the massive culvert pipe at Ulery and Liberty Roads, he spoke with the county and they agreed to repair them.

Cheryl advised 2 violation letters have been sent by both regular and certified mail to residents on Ellen Drive and Quail Ridge. She received a check from Waypoint for the funding plan balance owed to Pike Township, she also received the funding plan statements showing a claim paid in 1-2026 that was a carryover from 2025, the check was in the amount of \$ 9,789.92. Cheryl agrees with this figure.

Mr. Kaffenbarger received an email about Electric Aggregation, he forwarded to the other Trustees. He also wished everyone the best of luck as this is his last meeting. Cheryl asked him to turn in his key and info on putting the meeting dates on the website. She will also need the form declining insurance effective 7-1-2026.

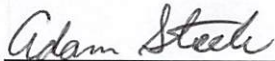
**R# 60 / 2026 HOLD A SPECIAL MEETING 6-6-26 FOR INTERVIEWS**
