Motion by Mr. Holder seconded by Mr. Maxson to appoint Andy Bowsman to the Pike Township Zoning Board to finish the term of Dan Meckstroth ending 12-31-2026.

Scott advised 273 runs for the year, 14 since last meeting, 2 MA for German Twp. The new EMT passed protocol and will be starting next week. They will be picking up the medic today to start the rechassis process.
