The Pike Township Trustees met in regular session August 18, 2026 for the purpose of conducting the business at hand. The Meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by the Board Vice President Dan Maxson with Zachery Holder answering the roll call. Also in attendance was Jerry Donnelly, Bob Miller and Cheryl Sigler.

All attendees stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes were not approved as Mr. Steele was not in attendance.

Bob advised he had an incident when he was working on the culvert on Dredge Road, he would like to order steel plates for when he does road work for safety reasons. He obtained a quote from Alro Steel

Motion by Mr. Holder seconded by Mr. Maxson to purchase a set of steel plates from Alro Steel at a cost not to exceed \$ 1,365.00. Motion passed.

8:33 a.m. Scott Williams and Teri Yoder enter.

Bob advised he is keeping up with the mowing, we have had lots of rain and the grass continues to grow. He is still seeking additional quotes for the Quail Ridge concrete job.

Scott advised 206 runs and all are turned in to Medicount. 1 MA run with NC. He advised we may need to pay for Drug license in 2029.

Jerry advised 3 runs since last meeting. He advised he has ordered the FH furniture. Steven Frost is now a Paramedic, they will get Cheryl the verification. He is looking to take the fleet for preventative maintenance at Midwest Truck. He received the 2027 Dispatching fee schedule, our cost will be \$ 22.77 per call, up .77 from 2026. Cost estimate no more than \$ 15,000 for 2027.

Mr. Meckstroth had several handouts regarding swimming pools, Trustees advised him to hold off on sending out any violation letters, we are going to get a legal opinion on the issue. If changes are needed to the Zoning regulations, they will do this, the data center updates and possibly garage sale signs all at the same time. Cheryl read and had him sign an Oath of Office.

Mr. Holder sent the Prosecutor a lengthy email regarding swimming pools, we are waiting on a response. he is also checking into Data Center regulations to implement. Verbiage will be received, reviewed and sent to the prosecutor for approval before we start the 3 readings to update the zoning manual.

Cheryl received the agreement from Clark County Community Development for Zoning Services. This will be tabled until next meeting.

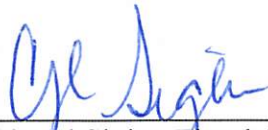
Bob mentioned the FH and shop will need to be painted. Would like to get a quote to do them at the same time.
