The Pike Township Trustees met in regular session February 17, 2026 for the purpose of conducting the business at hand. This meeting was held at the Firehouse due to the North Hampton water tower coming down today, and the office being closed off.

The Meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by the Board President Greg Kaffenbarger, with Vice President Adam Steele and Dan Maxson answering the roll call. Also in attendance was Jerry Donnelly, Scott Williams, Steven Frost, Brett Brown, Bob Miller and Cheryl Sigler.

All attendees stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

R# 17 / 2026 APPROVE FEBRUARY 3, 2026 MINUTES

Motion by Mr. Steele seconded by Mr. Maxson to approve the February 3, 2026 meeting minutes.

Scott advised 83 runs to date, 28 since last meeting, 10 mutual aid, 9 NC and 1 Miami Co. He also has a new applicant coming in 2-24-26 who is a retired EMT FF. He did hear back from the Prosecutor regarding the PTO policy verbiage, he suggested a change of 1 sentence , Medicount revalidation paperwork submitted with a copy to Cheryl.

The Trustees asked if any more discussion was done regarding the PTO policy, Jerry advised he does not feel the policy is needed yet, there have been new applications come in or picked up.

Jerry advised 1 fire run since last meeting. A letter dated 2-11-2026 was emailed advising the Safety Grant has been awarded to us in the amount of \$ 1,015.56, it is supposed to be direct deposited, Cheryl will let him know if it does not come in by the end of the month. He submitted an accident report for the Medic 153, it was the side mirror and has been fixed. They are discussing a Good Faith Agreement for Fire fighting side and sending a draft to the Prosecutor to review. He submitted a bill to Cheryl from onspot for a part for the Medic to be reimbursed to David Richardson, tax was added to the invoice, Jerry said David submitted the order before getting my note regarding future orders going thru her. The Fire Dept is seeking a donation for a 2026 Polaris to assist the medics if they have a run that the medic cannot get to in a field or woods. A grain bin training will be held September 19th at the Kaffenbarger farms.

Scott priced a new medic \$ 319,000 plus a 2 year wait, a discussion of transferring the current box to a new chassis for \$ 200,000. He will seek quotes.

Nicole advised the Sams Club membership is coming due, Scott will be deleted, she will call and remove him if she can.

Bob advised the light on the pole barn has been fixed, service truck is going to Knapheide for bed spray.

Mr. Maxson had a call about the bump on Myers Road S, Bob said that will be on his list for 2026.

Roll Call Vote: Mr. Kaffenbarger; yes Mr. Steele; yes Mr. Maxson; yes Motion passed.


